Golden hawk policies.

- All Set up will be done on Sunday November 16, 2008 starting at 8am, ready by 9:30am.. All Vendors MUST enter through our west dock entrance, no loading/unloading may take place in front of building
- Two (2) Admission passes will be provided for vendor and their helpers. Any additional passes needed for vendors or helpers will need to be purchased in advance.
- It is a violation of Michigan Liquor Control Commission laws to introduce any form of alcoholic beverage not purchased on the Golden Hawk premises for consumption. Golden Hawk maintains a zero-tolerance policy regarding violations of MLCC laws. Alcohol being brought in may result in event termination.
- Golden Hawk reserves the right to enforce MLCC laws to refuse service of alcoholic beverages to anyone appearing intoxicated and to close the bars at management's discretion. All persons of legal drinking age must supply a valid driver's license when requested.
- Golden Hawk is not responsible for any lost, damaged or stolen personal property of any kind prior to, during, or following any function.
- Golden Hawk reserves the right to move functions to other meeting/banquet rooms other than those appearing on the contract without prior notification.
- Any items to be displayed in the club or any directional signs must be approved by Golden Hawk.
- The vendor is responsible and will reimburse the club for any damage, loss or liability incurred to the club by any of the customers' guests or organizations contracted by the customer to provide any services or goods before, during and after the function. The vendor agrees to indemnify and hold the club, and its officers, directors, owners, employees and agents harmless from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities (including reasonable attorneys' fees, whether incurred in preparation for trial, on appeal or in bankruptcy proceedings) joint or several, to which the club may become subject as a result of this agreement or any default thereunder.
- Force Majeure. Golden Hawk will not be liable for delays, damages or failures in performance due to events of force majeure (causes beyond our reasonable control), including, but not limited to, acts of a governmental body, acts of God, acts of third parties, fires, floods, strikes or other labor related disputes, an inability to obtain necessary equipment or services, the severing of off-site communication lines by a third party, or other events of force majeure.

Either party may cancel this Agreement, with written notice to the other, without liability as a result of acts of God, over which neither party has control, government regulation, terrorism, disaster, strikes, civil disorders, unavailability of transportation facilities consistent with those in existence at the time of contract, or any other factors over which neither party has control, making it impossible or illegal to conduct the program consistent with those conditions that existed at the time the contract was executed. The parties may, however, agree to go forward on such terms and conditions that may be re-negotiated.
- All guests must follow appropriate dress code. Golden Hawk reserves the right to ask guests to leave if not properly dressed.
- No confetti or dance dust, rice or birdseed is allowed at Golden Hawk. (If used there will be an additional clean-up fee charged.) No tape, tacs, or staples allowed on walls, bars, etc. No candles or open flames allowed.
